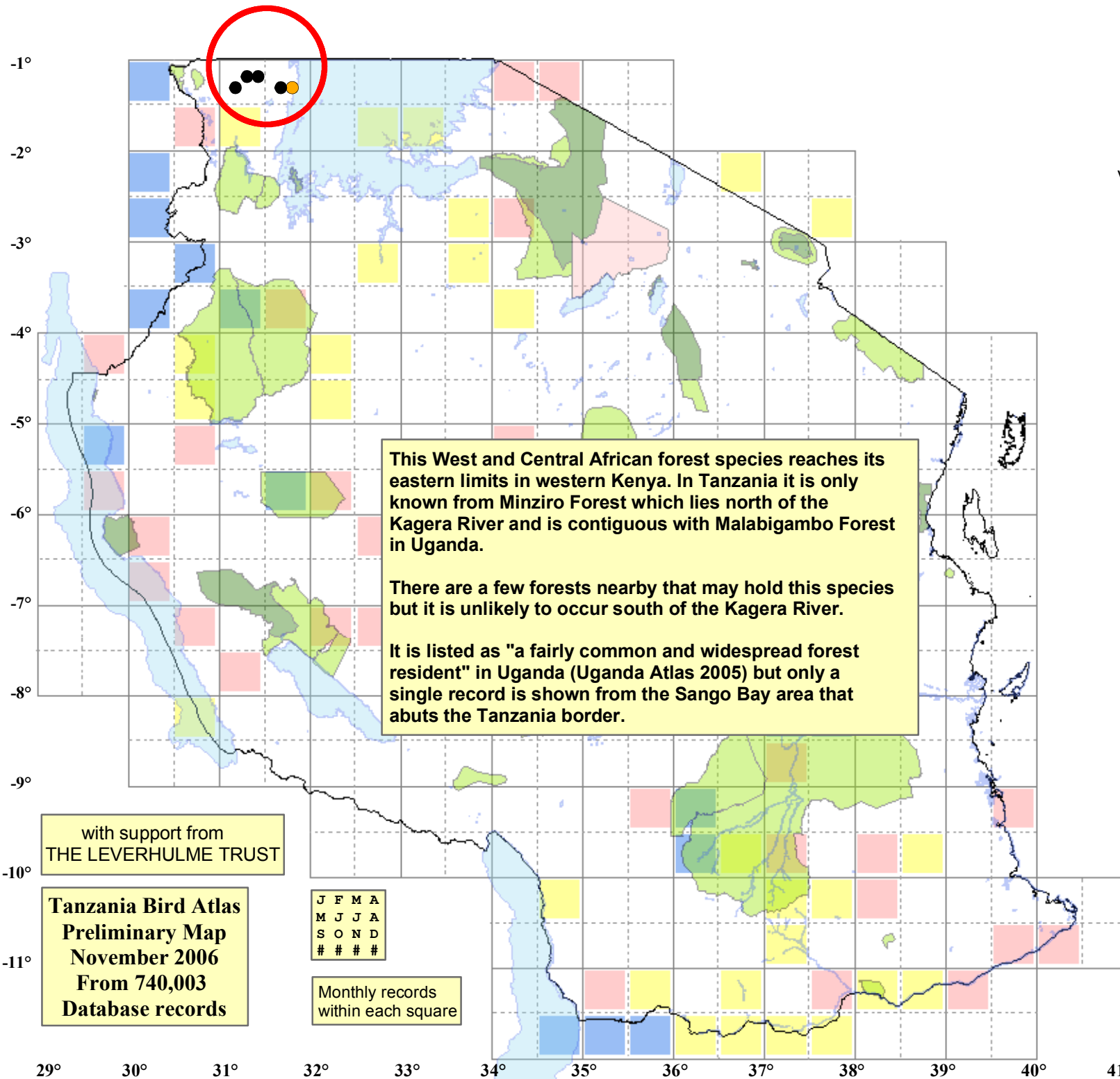

This West and Central African forest species reaches its eastern limits in western Kenya. In Tanzania it is only known from Minziro Forest which lies north of the Kagera River and is contiguous with Malabigambo Forest in Uganda.

There are a few forests nearby that may hold this species but it is unlikely to occur south of the Kagera River.

It is listed as "a fairly common and widespread forest resident" in Uganda (Uganda Atlas 2005) but only a single record is shown from the Sango Bay area that abuts the Tanzania border.
