



How curious that we should have so few records for the cooler months of July and August when these are the months for which we have the most records overall. Does this species leave the high ground during the cool season? where might it move to? any discernible patterns here?

Britton (1980) suggests that nominate birds occur south to Mahale NP and that birds south and east may be the southern race *N. c. chalcea*.

This record from the Western Corridor may be the first for the Serengeti.
