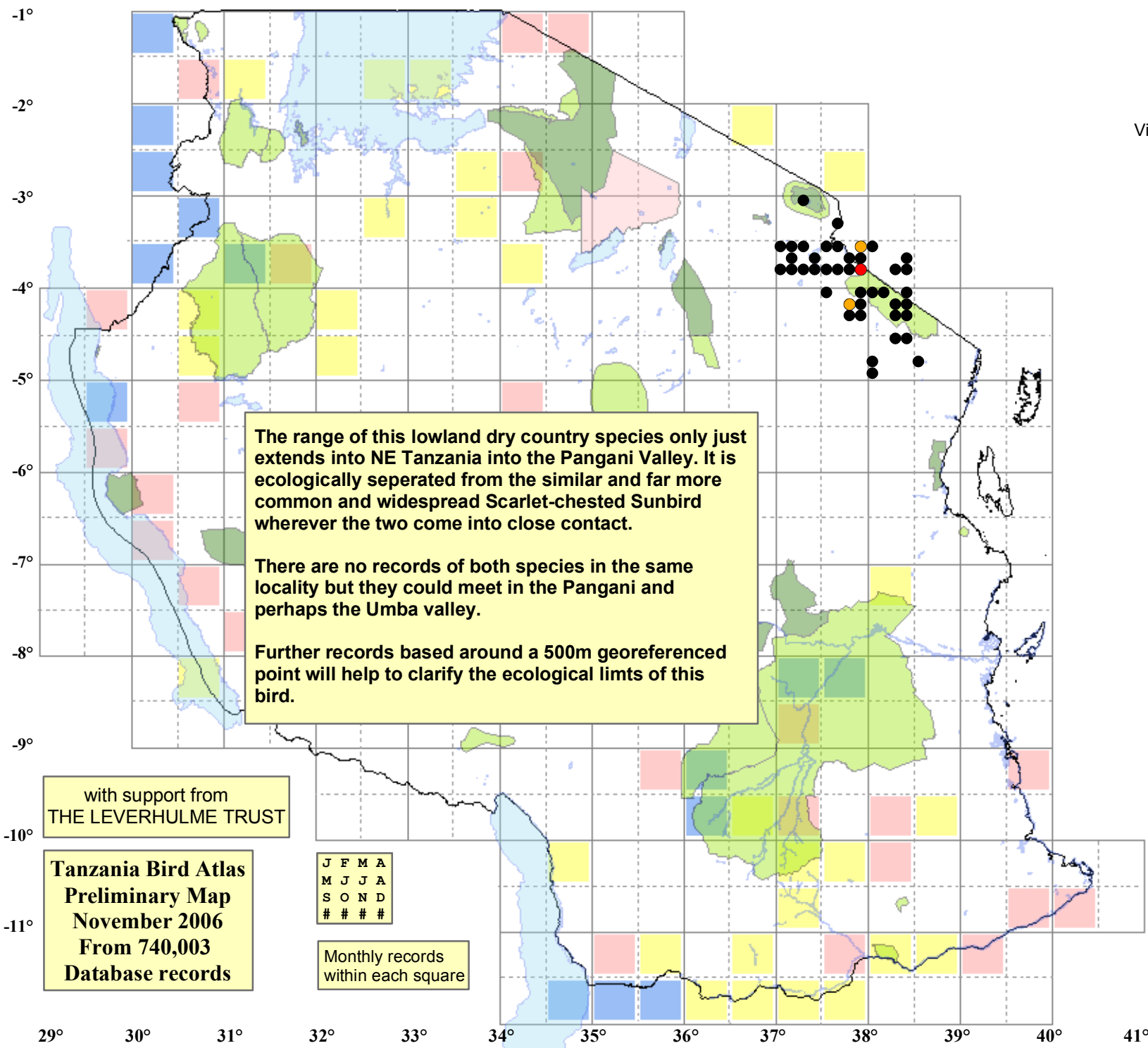

The range of this lowland dry country species only just extends into NE Tanzania into the Pangani Valley. It is ecologically separated from the similar and far more common and widespread Scarlet-chested Sunbird wherever the two come into close contact.

There are no records of both species in the same locality but they could meet in the Pangani and perhaps the Uмба valley.

Further records based around a 500m georeferenced point will help to clarify the ecological limits of this bird.
