

The population estimate is only 50-100,000 birds with a 1% threshold of 750 birds.

5,107 were counted by 13 teams in Jan 1995 and 8,335 by 17 teams in Jan 2005. Clearly Tanzania is important for this species.

Baker (1996 gives a population estimate for Tanzania of 7,000 to 10,000 birds. This should be revised upwards, perhaps 12,000 to 15,000 is more likely.

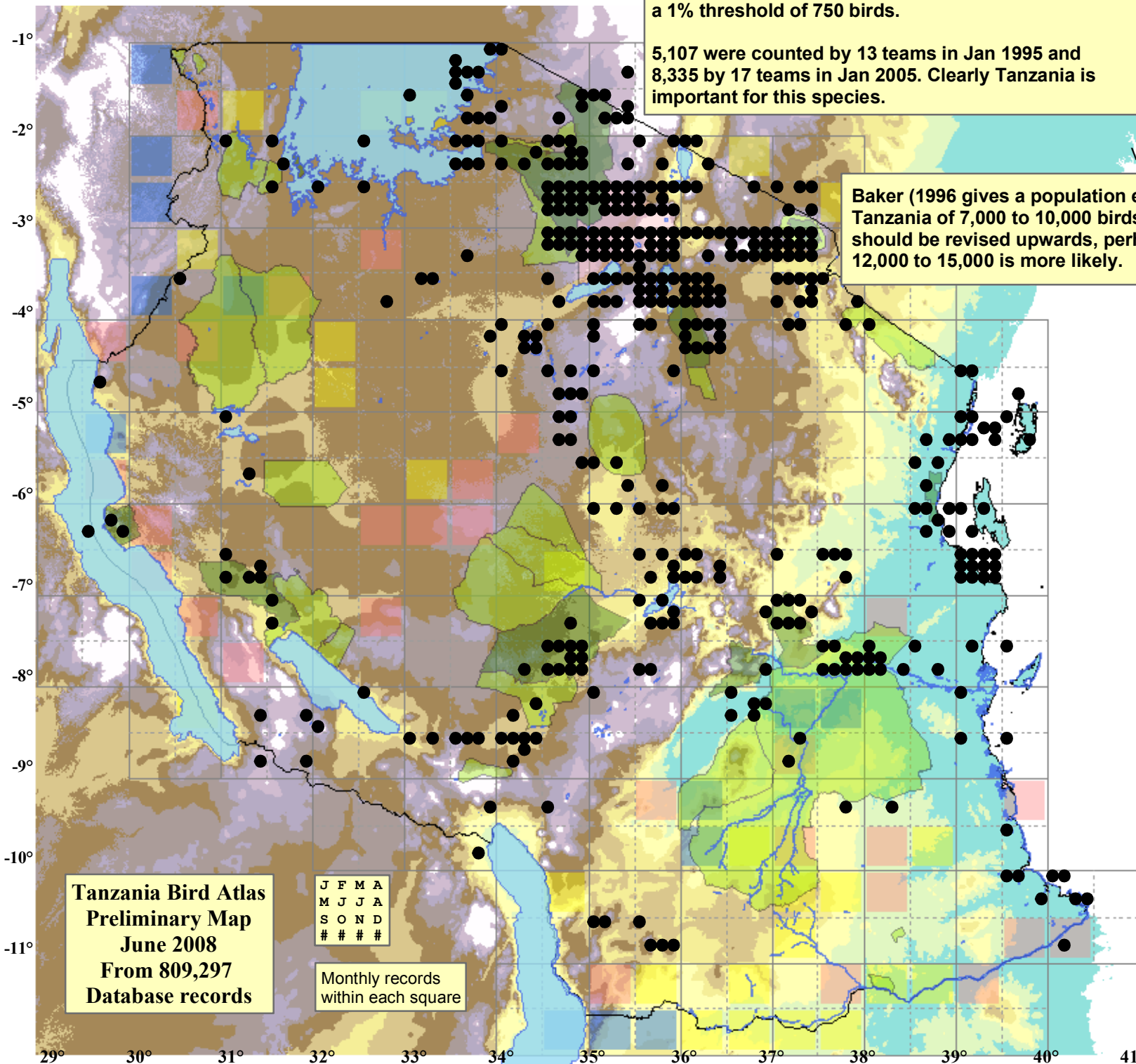
