

Tanzania still holds significant numbers of this increasingly threatened species. It is tempting to speculate that the 1,400 or so birds 'wintering' at Nyumba ya Mungu dam in square 3703C are indeed the birds which breed on the Ruaha, Kilombero and Rufiji rivers. Large flocks are increasingly rare. We need to know if the 5 'sites' shown here are the only ones of any importance for non-breeding concentrations.

The 5 'wintering' sites (where birds have been reported in flocks) are:-

- Nyumba ya Mungu (1,400)
- Lake Singida
- Mtera Dam (143 Aug 2004)
- Katavi NP
- Lake Rukwa (250 in Jan 95)

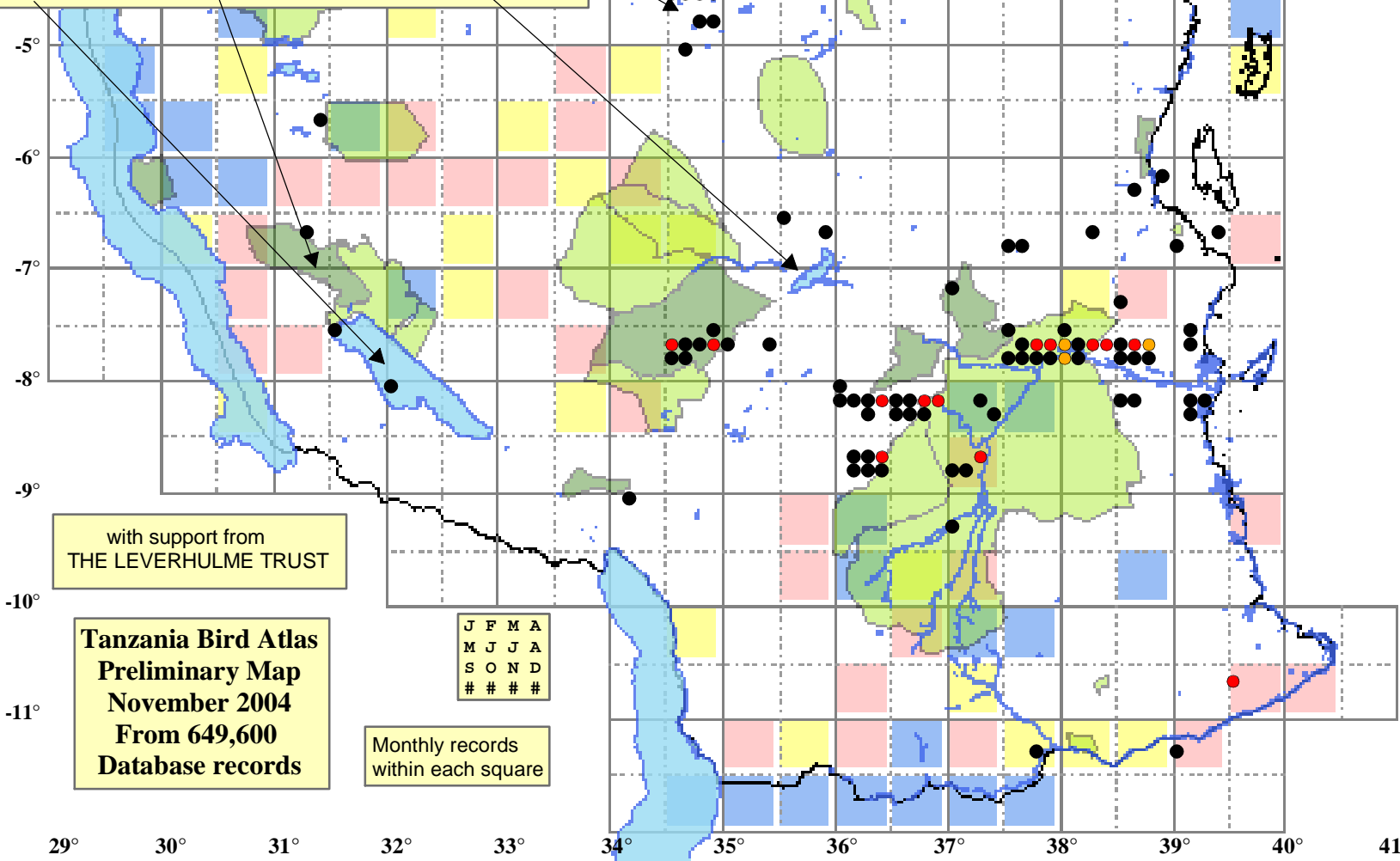
