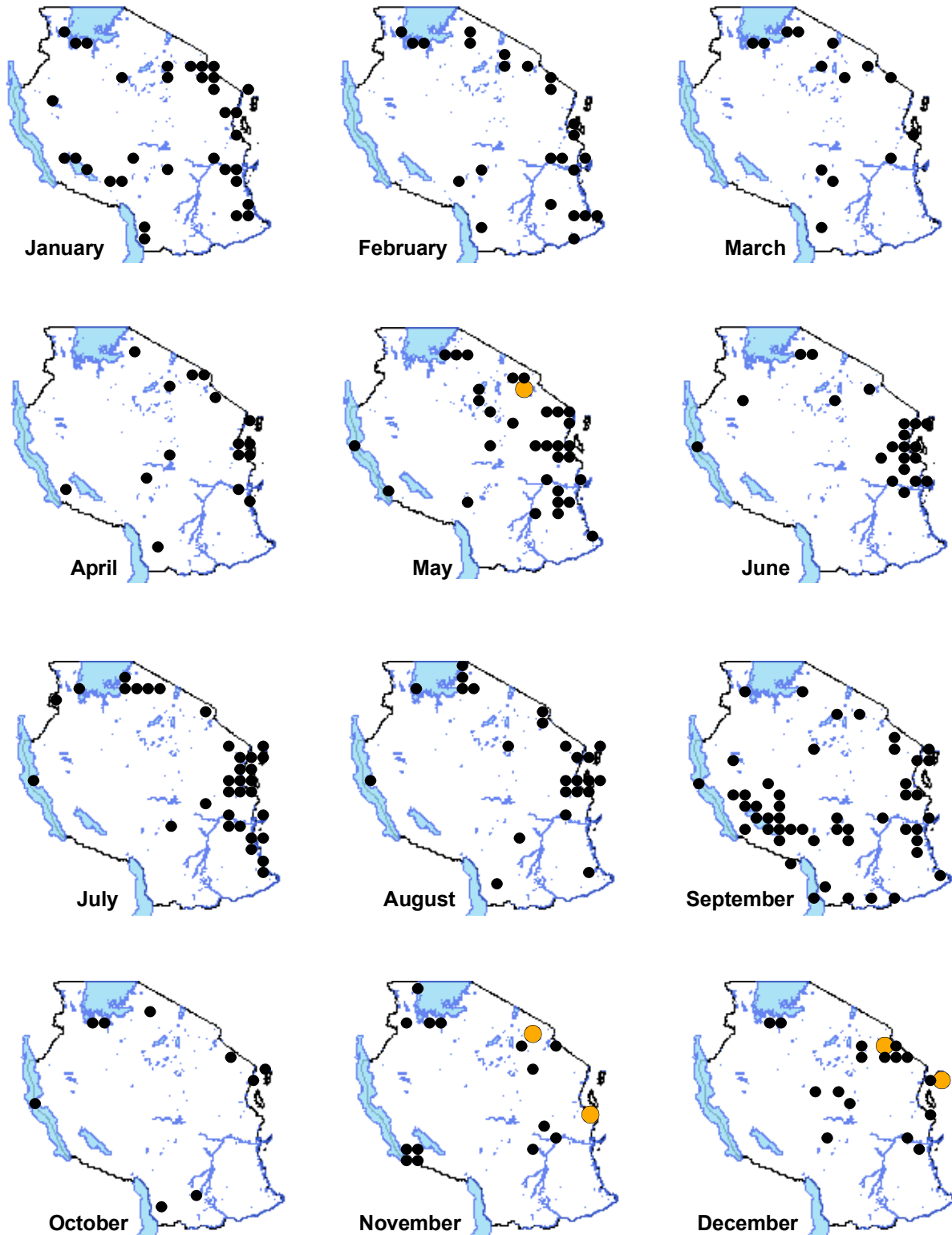


Madagascar Bee-eater *Merops superciliosus*: monthly distribution within Tanzania



This complex situation may be exaggerated by identification errors when Blue-cheeked are in country but just look at that concentration of records in the SW during September. Clearly indicative of large scale movement which Fry (1981) suggests is southerly, continuing through Zambia and Malawi.

Similar concentrations in the coastal lowlands are more indicative of partial residence from May to August with perhaps a southward movement in September.
