This recent obs by Jo Anderson of birds moving south through the NCA is only our 5th record of birds on passage but it fits well with previous ones from the Serengeti and Tarangire.

Fieldwork these past two seasons by Liz and our team have improved our knowledge of the breeding range, esp the altitudinal limits. However we still know little of the birds biology in Tanzania and how these outrageous pine and gum plantations will affect the population size other than to say more trees equals less birds.
