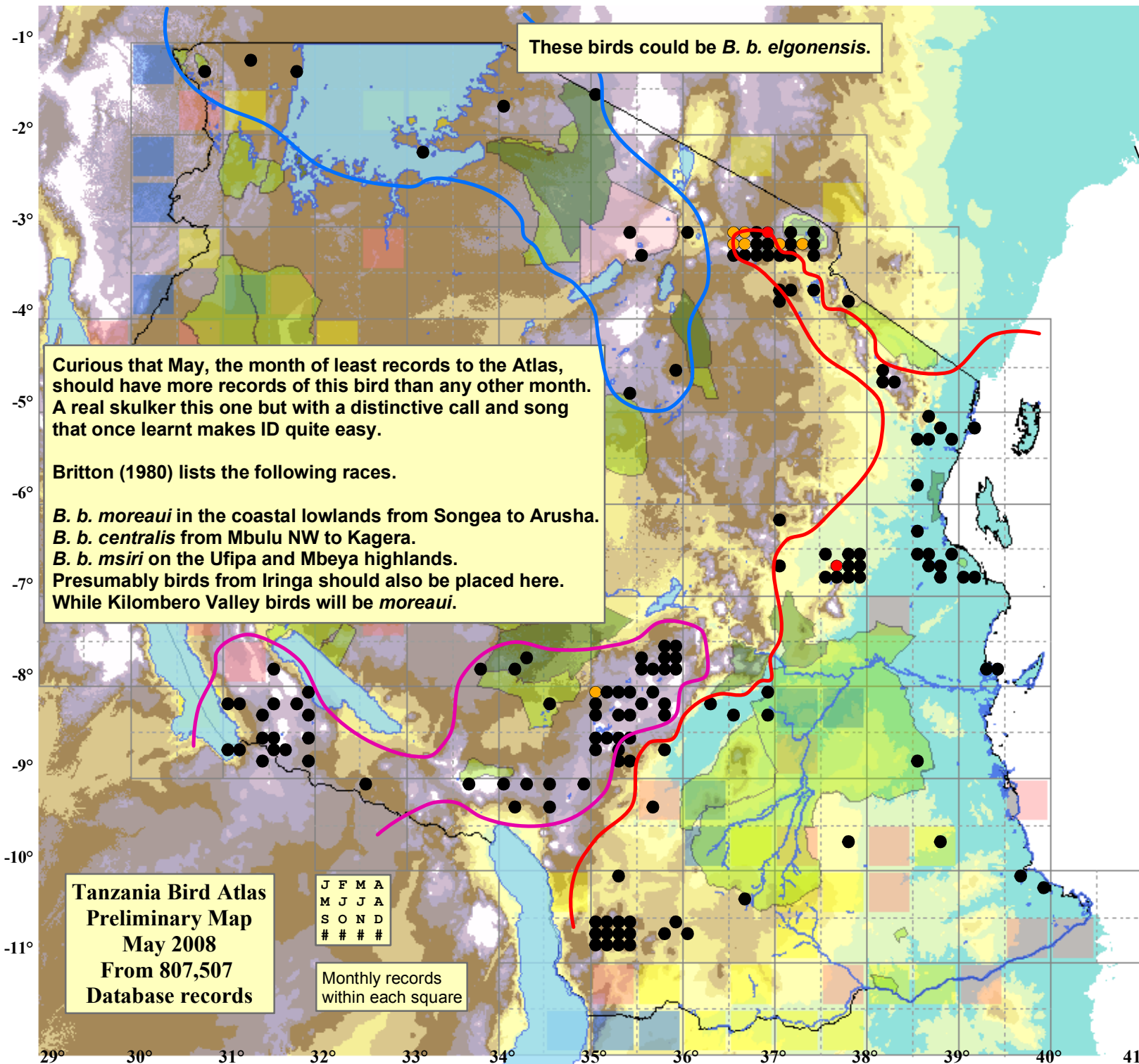


# Little Rush Warbler

*Bradypterus baboecala*

156 plots from 429 records



These birds could be *B. b. elgonensis*.

Curious that May, the month of least records to the Atlas, should have more records of this bird than any other month. A real skulker this one but with a distinctive call and song that once learnt makes ID quite easy.

Britton (1980) lists the following races.

*B. b. moreaui* in the coastal lowlands from Songea to Arusha.  
*B. b. centralis* from Mbulu NW to Kagera.  
*B. b. msiri* on the Ufipa and Mbeya highlands.  
 Presumably birds from Iringa should also be placed here.  
 While Kilombero Valley birds will be *moreaui*.
